Mount Paran North Tennis Captain's Meeting

Team Registration

- 1) The Sports Ministry must have notification of a team's request to play out of our courts two weeks prior to the ALTA roster deadline for each season. Any returning team not meeting the deadline may lose their spot to a new team after the deadline.
- 2) All rosters, money, and requested practice day are due in the office one week before the ALTA captain's meeting.
- 3) We will have a mandatory captain's meeting the week following the ALTA captain's meetings.
- 4) Registration may be completed on-line by each member of your team using a credit card or captains may continue to collect and turn in the fees by teams. The court fees are \$25 per person per team. There will be a maximum of \$400 per team.

Team Rosters

- 1) Captains must be Mount Paran North members or staff.
- 2) Currently we do not require a percentage of Mount Paran North members to be on a team. However, rosters must indicate who is a Mount Paran North members/staff.
- 3) Once rosters are submitted to the office, each player will be set up in the system. Each team will have a team page where you can easily communicate with the team and the office.

Courts/Equipment

- 1) When a team has completed the registration process, the captain will be given the code for the lock on the tennis storage building. This will be given at the captains meeting each season. The building will contain the score boards, squeegees, gas blower, and ice chest.
- 2) Please notify the office by email on any missing or broken equipment.

Practice/game courts

- 1) Teams are guaranteed at least two courts for practice nights. If you are the only team with practice you may use all courts. However, rain-out matches can use two courts when needed to make-up a rained out home match.
- 2) Teams will have all four courts available for home matches.

Rain-out Matches/Reserving Courts

- 1) A calendar will be available on the tennis page of the website. To reserve a court, captains must email the office (lb@mtparan.com, lisab@mtparan.com). We will update the calendar and email you back with confirmation.
- 2) For rain-out matches, some standards have been established:

Thursday Women: Make up matches in the mornings/afternoon.

Business Women: Make up matches on practice night or Saturday after men's match**

Men's: Make up on practice night or on Sunday after 4pm**.

** Contact the Men's or Women's captain of the team playing at home. If they are using all courts, you should be able to start earlier – as soon as a court is cleared. If they are not using all the courts, you should be able to start early as well on the far court. However, both captains should be aware of what is going on and both need to be considerate to each team's matches.

- 3) If two matches are being played at the same time (rain-out and a regularly schedule match), the regularly scheduled match will take the front side and the make-up will take the back side.
- 4) If conflicts arise, the earliest match to be rained out will take precedence over other rain-out matches (i.e., Men's is rained out on Saturday and the Women's is rained out on Sunday then the Men's make-up will take priority over the Women's make-up).
- 5) Rain-out make-up matches should be for home matches only. If there is a date available and no home make-ups are being played, we will allow captains to make-up away matches. However, in this situation your team would get the lowest priority.

Make sure you keep an updated copy of the tennis calendar with you at matches and follow the rain-out rules as much as possible. When needed, two courts can be used when another team is practicing.

Remember: Scheduling Rain-out matches are not fun for anyone. Without lights, it is even harder for our teams. Please be considerate and understanding during these times.
